The team are required to not only prepare the menu but as part of the Numeracy studies need to approximate the value of their shopping and

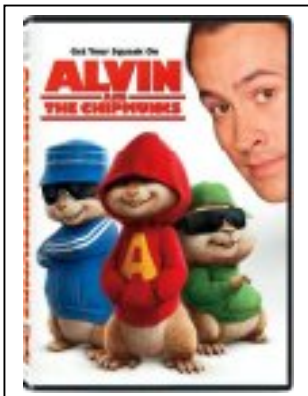
look at cost per kilo and best value items, as well as ensuring that they have every item on their shopping lists.
