

School Structure

The school is divided into 3 sections with each led by a Leading Teacher. Each section is responsible for their curriculum and management issues. There is a whole school approach to developing resilience in our students.

Curriculum Years Prep – Year 5

Early Year students focus on literacy and numeracy skills and social skill development.

Curriculum Years 6 – Year 9

Middle Year students focus on life skills, functional learning and age appropriate activities.

VCAL Years 10 – Years 12

Senior students focus on life skills, functional learning and post school options. They are able to select from a number of Vocation Educational & Training (VET) courses.
