Congratulations to Darryl who came home with a silver medal for freestyle, and Claire with a silver medal in backstroke!





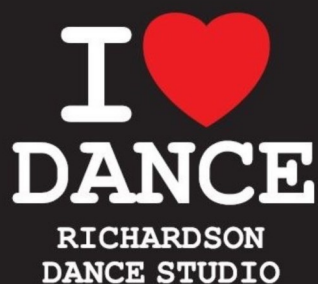
